



ENHANCED MEDICAL RESPONSE @ DSR











Brandon Daruna with Eagle County Paramedics came out to do some medical response awareness training; and Flight for Life Colorado brought out "LIFEGUARD 2" to engage with our staff and better acquaint with DSR with regard to a medevac perspective. We now have Landing Zone kits to be better prepared to assist a medevac process; and both medical response organizations now have a quick-reference sheet for DSR to assist when/if they are called. Combined with our annual CPR / First Aid training, we are better prepared for an incident. Something we of course never want to occur but always want to be prepared for. We are thankful to both Eagle County Paramedics and Flight for Life Colorado for taking the time to engage with us on these very important topics.






